

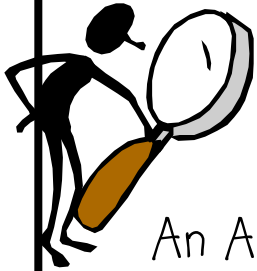

What do you EXPECT to see at a grocery store? Be specific.

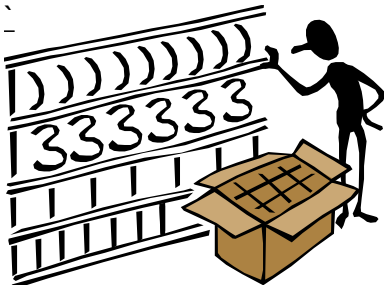

Grocery store owners craft displays **ON PURPOSE WITH** the **INTENT** to draw customers' attention and influence them to consider buying the highlighted products.

Grocery store owners choose music **ON PURPOSE WITH** the **INTENT** to create a tone that is appropriate for an audience that is buying groceries. Slower music will make it more likely that the shoppers will stay in the store longer and spend more money.

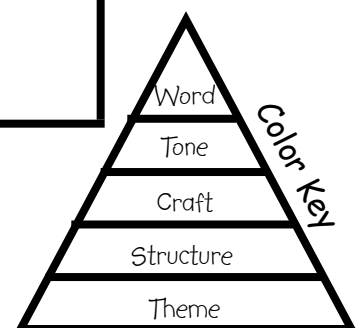
Giving Trees
